### We speak for you in court

All parents have the right to choose home education for their children. The Pestalozzi Trust Legal Defence Fund for Home Education is committed to advocating the fundamental elements of this right: religious freedom; the right of parents to educate their children according to their own convictions: and the right of children to be cared for by their parents without interference with their privacy and their family. We are prepared to represent our member families every step of the way from consultation to correspondence and negotiation with local officials, and in court proceedings all the way through the appellate courts. The Trust will pay all litigation costs for home school cases it undertakes.

### If home education is legal, why do we need a legal defence fund?

There are several answers to this - one might point to the fact that corruption and theft are illegal, vet some government officials regularly commit those crimes. As a result, pensions medical treatment, or other services may be withheld. Similarly, we find that, in all countries where home education is recognised by law, families often find their right to educate their children at home challenged by government officials - for reasons unrelated to the interest of the child.

Since home education became legal in South Africa, home educated children have been unlawfully removed from their parents. Unauthorised persons have terminated registrations for education at home. Families have been refused registration without adequate reason, or with no reasons given at all.

Indeed: until now, those families who attempted to act within the law are the ones who have experienced most problems from government officials.

The main reason is this: Most officials responsible for home education do not know the law that they are required to apply, and they have no knowledge of home education either.

For this reason, home educators are consistently forced to ask the courts to defend their rights against unlawful actions by education and other officials.

### We speak for you at National Government

The Trust monitors national legislation and maintains relationships with key legislators and officials as well as with our fellow family-friendly organisations. We are equipped to support representative home schooling associations and home schooling our families to lobby representatives on issues affecting home educators, to make informed inputs in processes where policy is formulated and to disseminate emergency alerts to volunteers and associates nation-wide by fax and e-mail.

### We speak for you in Provincial Governments

The Trust helps provincial home school leaders by tracking provincial legislation and policy initiatives, alerting them to bills, regulations, and policies which may affect home educators, and by fighting harmful legislation and policies. At the invitation of provincial home school organisations, the Trust will assist with drafting statutes to improve their home school legal environment.

The Pestalozzi Trust does not draw on its own strength alone. We receive active support from the Home School Legal Defence Association and others who have blazed the way for home educators in the USA (where nearly two million children are now educated at home). Their experience through decades of legal and legislative struggle is of inestimable value to home schoolers in South Africa.

We also share information, experience, and mutual support with jurists, pedagogues, and home school leaders in other countries including Australia, Canada, Namibia, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Sweden, and the United Kingdom. History shows that home education in South Africa would almost certainly have been illegal now if it were not for international support in the past, and at least one South African home schooling family has been reunited as a result of international pressure on the government.

We invest in cultivating cordial relations with home education leadership in other countries in the event that yours is the family who may need it in future.

## Who are we?

We are a Christian ministry that advocates the right of all families to educate their children at home regardless of their religious affiliation. We are committed to home education, not only as a legal right, but also as an educational opportunity and spiritual blessing. We believe that God has blessed the efforts of home schooling families and home school leaders on behalf of the home schooling community throughout South Africa.

Our international Board of Trustees includes jurists and educationists who are leaders in the field of home education, family rights, and related fundamental rights, leaders in the field of financial management and control, as well as advocates of home education and home educators of long standing.

Our mission is to support those efforts to defend and advance the constitutional rights of parents to direct the education of their children and to protect family freedoms. Our task is to provide the best expertise obtainable to discover and develop the expertise that will be necessary to guard and expand the freedom with which God has blessed home schoolers.

### We are here for your family

When you have a problem that needs immediate attention, we are just a phone call away - 24 hours a day. The Pestalozzi Trust enables our members to home school their children in peace and freedom.

# What kinds of assistance do we give?

If a government official challenges your right to home school, the Trust will be there to support you with legal and pedagogical expertise, advising and representing you at every stage of proceedings against you. As a member of the Pestalozzi Trust Legal Defence Fund for Home Education you will be able to obtain consultation by letter and telephone, representation in negotiations with local officials, and representation in court proceedings.

### The board of trustees

Dr Chris Klicka from Virginia in the USA serves as senior council for the Home School Legal Defence Association in his own country and member of the board of the HSLDA (Canada). He was the first lawyer to establish himself in a full time career defending the rights of home educators.

Mr **Henri Slabbert** is a home schooling leader and a school teacher with specialist qualifications in education management.

Mr Leendert van Oostrum (Executive Chairman) has provided leadership on home education policy for longer than a decade. He received an M.Ed degree for his research on home education.

### The cost

The standard fee for the Legal Defence Fund for Home Education, operated by the Pestalozzi Trust, is R960 per family per annum (subject to change). Discounts to families who join the Trust within 3 months of starting home schooling, as well as additional to discounts to families who joined before 1 February 2008, and to members of registered support groups.

The Trust can also take the offensive, filing actions to protect members against government intrusion and to establish legal precedent. We are able to help our members through the initial stages of child abuse and neglect investigations, which have become a method to intimidate home schoolers. We remain involved in follow-up litigation if home schooling is an issue.

Although the Trust does not take divorce or custody cases, we will provide helpful information and may, when there is an opportunity to set precedent, approach the court in an *amicus curiae* capacity supporting the rights of a home schooling parent.

### Your information source

Our regular *newsletter* will update you on what is going on in your province and around the country, reporting on trends, issues, and items of general interest to home educators. Our *web site* will put helpful resources, news, and information at your fingertips 24 hours a day.

Fax Alerts and E-lerts (alerts by e-mail). These messages will keep regional leaders and subscribing members current on "hot" legislative and government issues that need their attention.

Conference Speakers. Our trustees and staff offer vision, encouragement, and helpful how-to-home-school information.

### The wisdom of experience

Nobody sets out to get into a legal battle, but it can happen at any time - primarily because our laws and policies on home, education are developing in a country where the practice is new and strange to government and society alike.

Our law on home education is, by admission of the governing party, based on ignorance of home education and often policies are prepared by officials who have no knowledge of the tested and legitimate practices of home educators, their rights and freedoms.

Our staff can assist you in carefully planning and establishing your home school in a way that can be well defended against challenge by government officials. We are also able to refer you to resources and organisations to help you.

# A neighbour to your home schooling "neighbour"

Scripture instructs us to "love our neighbours as ourselves." Even if your family never needs to call the Legal Defence Fund, your membership will help other home schooling families who desperately need our expertise. ### The Pestalozzi Trust undertakes:

During the time that your family is a member of the Pestalozzi Trust Legal Defence Fund for Home Education (the Fund), we undertake to:

- 1 Treat all information as confidential and use it solely to prepare for any potential legal defence in relation to your home education.
- Exercise due diligence in administering all contributions by Members as an indivisible part of the Fund to defend, by the most appropriate means as determined by the Trustees, your right to home education against unlawful encroachment by the legislative, executive, or judicial branches of government.
- 3 Provide quality legal representation on any actual or threatened criminal proceedings brought against you in relation to your home education.
- 4 Pay all fees for attorneys and advocates appointed by the Trust, and court costs resulting from criminal proceedings brought against you in relation to home education.
- Decline to assist in the defence of a Member or in an appeal against a decision and decline to continue to render assistance in a matter if, in the exclusive discretion of the Trustees, the likely result in regard to legal precedent or the cost will be detrimental to your interests or those of other Members.
- 6 Communicate with you via a regular newsletter regarding any information that will affect your home education.
- 7 Serve as advocates and lobby in the public policy arena for your right to home education.

The Trust reserves the right to refuse any application and to revoke membership where information has been misrepresented in the application.

You must submit your payment or a copy of your stop order with your application. Date the first payment on a stop order for the first day of the month following the date that is six weeks after sending in your application.

Membership does not commence on receipt of the application (processing an application may take from three to six weeks). Membership commences on the first day of the month following the date on which the application has been reviewed, approved, and entered into our membership database or on the date of first payment on a stop order, if that is later. No refund is available once accepted into membership.

You will receive notification of approval of your application as well as a member's package. If we cannot approve your application we will return your payment and send you a letter of explanation. If you do not hear from us within six weeks after you sent in your application, please contact our office at admin@pestalozzi.org to inquire about the status of your application. NB: It does happen that faxes or e-mails or ordinary mail sometimes are not delivered for reasons unknown to anyone, even if your fax machine or e-mail shows it to have been sent/received.

Membership is valid for a period of 12 months from the date of commencement (see above) unless a) the family should stop home education, in which case it ceases automatically; or b) the member discontinues payment of fees, in which case it ceases with the last payment.

### Categories of membership

Standard Membership. The membership fee is R960 per family per annum (subject to change). Families who join within 3 months of starting home schooling pay a discount fee of R840. Families who joined before the 1st of February, 2008, and whose membership remains uninterrupted, receive an additional discount. A further additional community discount is granted to members of home schooling support groups registered with the Trust (contact us for particulars).

Associate Membership. Associate membership is granted to non-homeschoolers who want to support the Trust, and to homeschoolers whose children are not yet or no longer of school-going age. The associate membership fee is R420 per annum.

PLEASE NOTE: All members and associate members with whom we have to communicate via normal mail instead of e-mail are liable to a surcharge of R60 per annum.

#### Privileges of membership

Members have access to the home school library of the Trust. Members may also attend meetings of the Trust at a discount fee.
